The Illumina Agricultural Greater Good Initiative grants, launched in 2011, are awarded annually. This program spurs critically needed research that will increase the sustainability, productivity, and nutritional density of agriculturally important crop and livestock species. Grant recipients receive donations of Illumina products to support their projects.

The grant program is open to basic researchers in agrigenomics at academic or nonprofit institutions through December 4, 2020.

Researchers dedicated to making tangible contributions through research for increased sustainability, productivity, and nutritional density of the world's food supply are encouraged to apply. Submissions are judged on scientific merit, innovation, and fit with the theme.

The Grand Prize winner will receive 20 terabases of Illumina NovaSeq sequencing data on samples of your choice (check Terms and Conditions).
